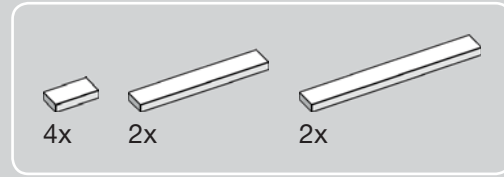
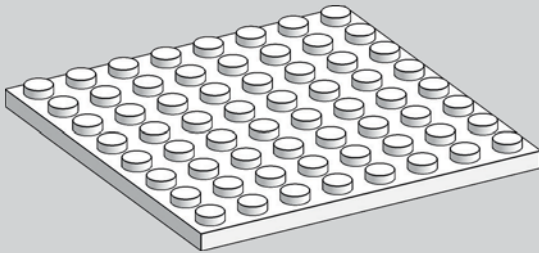
Dieses Modell enthält viele typische Elemente des Neoklassizismus, unter anderem ein auffälliges Kuppeldach.
